Group Buy Selection: Goats, Lambs and Pigs

Selection times may be adjusted.

General Guidelines

1. Selection process will be modified to accommodate for 2020 due to Klein ISD guidance in response to student, staff and family safety due to COVID19. The guidelines for student pre-screening prior entering a Klein ISD facility is located [here](#).
2. All facilities are Klein ISD properties and face masks will be required during the selection process. In addition when applicable safe distancing is recommended.
3. If a student is unable to attend due to a daily COVID19 screening at home or currently quarantining due to COVID19 a teacher from the respective campus will select the project for the student.
4. A student who is not present due to an approved Klein ISD function or under COVID quarantine as reported to Klein ISD will have their animal selected by the teacher. Students that are not present for any other reason will be moved to the end of the draw and have their project selected by the teacher.
5. The draw for selection order due to COVID19 will be done by a random draw process. This will be done virtually and recorded. A teacher from each campus and Klein Show Assn staff will be witnessing the process for verification. The selection order for each species will be released to the teachers and posted on the show website for viewing.
6. For the selection process a modified schedule will be followed to reduce the number of individuals in the facility at one time. Each student selecting will be allotted the same amount of time to view as well as during selection itself.
7. Students selecting will be able to have (1) one person with them for viewing prior to the start of selection. When selection starts only the student will be allowed in the area for selection. Teachers will be assisting students in locating their selection and moving the project out of the selection area. Additional assistance from non participant students selected by the teachers and show association staff will be assisting the movement of the animal.
8. Once selection starts each student will have (3) minutes to make their selection. While a student is selecting the next 2 students will be able to view in preparation for selection.
9. The student must remain with the animal after selection until the animal has been processed which includes hair sample collection and veterinary inspection for swine. Your parent/guardian must be available to sign paperwork or the student can submit a waiver provided by your instructor.

Specie Guidance

Goat Selection

1. Goat selection will take place on Friday, October 9, 2020. The selection will take place at the Klein HS Agscience Farm at 6747 Klein Cemetery Rd. Spring, TX 77379.
2. In view of safety of students, parents and staff the viewing and selection will be split into 3 different groups based on draw number. Each group will be allotted the same amount of time (45 minutes) for viewing prior to starting selection for that group. Only that group of students and (1) parent/guardian or friend will be allowed in the facility for viewing during that allotted time.
3. Numbers selected by each group will be provided during the process.
 - a. Group 1 will begin viewing at 10:45am and selecting at 11:30am
 - b. Group 2 will begin viewing at approximately 12:15pm or the completion of group 1. Selection will follow at approximately 1:00pm.
 - c. Group 3 will begin viewing at approximately 1:45pm or the completion of group 2. Selection will follow at approximately 2:30pm.
4. Times are approximate and it is encouraged to be early if the process is moving quickly.

Lamb Selection

5. Lamb selection will take place on Friday, October 9, 2020. The selection will take place at the Klein HS Agscience Farm at 6747 Klein Cemetery Rd. Spring, TX 77379.
6. In view of safety of students, parents and staff the viewing and selection will be split into 2 different groups based on draw number. Each group will be allotted the same amount of time (1 hour) for viewing prior to starting selection for that group. Only that group of students and (1) parent/guardian or friend will be allowed in the facility for viewing during that allotted time.
7. Numbers selected by each group will be provided during the process.
 - a. Group 1 will begin viewing at 4:00pm and selecting at 5:00pm
 - b. Group 2 will begin viewing at approximately 6:00pm or the completion of group 1. Selection will follow at approximately 7:00pm.
8. Times are approximate and it is encouraged to be early if the process is moving quickly.

Pig Selection

9. Pig selection will take place on Saturday, October 10, 2020. The selection will take place at the Klein Multipurpose Center 7500 FM2920 Spring, TX 77379.
10. Entrance to the facility will only be through the barn entrance between the buildings. Due to loading of livestock students / parents will be asked to park in front of the building.
11. In view of safety of students, parents and staff the viewing and selection will be split into 4 different groups based on draw number. Each group will be allotted the same amount of time (1 hour) for viewing prior to starting selection for that group. Only that group of students and (1) parent/guardian or friend will be allowed in the facility for viewing during that allotted time.
12. Numbers selected by each group will be provided during the process.
 - a. Group 1 will begin viewing at 7:00am and selecting at 8:00am
 - b. Group 2 will begin viewing at approximately 8:45am or the completion of group 1. Selection will follow at approximately 9:45am
 - c. Group 3 will begin viewing at approximately 10:30am or the completion of group 2. Selection will follow at approximately 11:30am.
 - d. Group 4 will begin viewing at approximately 12:15pm or the completion of group 3. Selection will follow at approximately 1:15pm.
13. Times are approximate and it is encouraged to be early if the process is moving quickly.
